One high spot of the season is that we only lost a few games because of the weather compared with last season where we lost in excess of 10.

The ground at Tanworth has looked a picture over the season and is a credit to our groundsmen Dave Brazier, Andy Brazier, Paul Shortley and Andy Turnbull.

We have had many challenges during the season planning to replacing the burnt down score board and electrics at Tanworth Lane and modifying the pavilion and car park at Rumbush lane to accommodate our new Tenants during the winter; Leaffield Ladies football team.

We are in contact with Solihull Active and WCS for help to apply for a grant from Sport England to improve facilities at Tanworth Lane and Rumbush Lane but will not know the outcome until April 2014.

We completed two 6-week cricket taster courses at Tanworth and Dickens Heath schools this season at no cost to the schools, in order to encourage the children to appreciate and join our junior cricket section. We are planning to repeat this next season as part of our 3-year plan to boost our junior membership.

On the playing side, one of the highlights this season is the eight centuries scored by individual players, the most in one season for over 40 years.

It was a mixed season on the cricketing front with the 1st team in a good position for promotion early in the season but injury and lack of availability due to holidays affected their progress. Praise must go to 16 year old Dan Wright for his splendid performance with bat and ball.

The 2nd and 3rd teams struggled but there were several outstanding individual performances, one of them being 14-year-old Alex Prosser who scored one century and a 94.

The U17 and mid week team had limited success but the U17 members did make many match winning performances in the senior team.

The Sunday and U12 teams had an outstanding season winning their respective leagues and the T20 cups in their divisions.
