Update on Village Green and Playground

The transfer of the Village Green from the Liquidator owners to Solihull MBC is progressing well - it should take place in the next few weeks, the solicitors are dealing with the final details. Once they own the land, SMBC will then advertise its disposal by way of a lease to the Parish Council – this is a legal requirement and the adverts will appear in local newspapers for 2 consecutive weeks. Solihull MBC will first have to consider any responses to the adverts, but are keen to then lease the Village Green and Playground to the Parish Council as soon as is practically possible. This has been a very long and drawn out process but it looks like success is in sight!
